



BLUECOATS MEMBERSHIP: Nominating Procedure

BLUECOATS MEMBERS are business and civic leaders of Cuyahoga County who are actively engaged in community affairs. Membership is limited to 1,000 Regular Members (members under 70 years of age). The Membership Committee will periodically review candidates proposed for membership and select the best-qualified persons to fill any Regular Member vacancies that may exist.

THE PROCEDURE TO NOMINATE a candidate for Membership is simple. A Member of Bluecoats must act as "Proposer," and another Member must act as "Secunder." Each should write a letter addressed to the Bluecoats Membership Committee identifying the candidate and stating why the candidate should be approved for Membership. The Proposer's letter should include:

- a) **the full name, date of birth and residence address of the candidate;**
- b) **the candidate's business affiliation, title, function, address and telephone and fax numbers, e-mail;**
- c) **the candidate's educational background and any club memberships;**
- d) **evidence of the candidate's business and civic leadership and community involvement; and**
- e) **other pertinent information about the candidate, including the length of time known;**

The Secunder's letter should amplify on items (d) and (e) above.
